Who Can Apply?

- ◆ UAlbany or FIU undergraduates, preferably with at least two years before graduation
- ◆ You must be eligible for a security clearance (Active security clearance not needed for applications)
- ◆ A GPA of 3.2 or higher is required

Program Requirements

- ◆ Pursue one cyber badge (3 cyber courses that aligns with coursework for the BS in Computer Engineering with a concentration in Cybersecurity or Digital Forensics or Network Security)
- ◆ Compete in at least one cybersecurity competition per academic year
- ◆ Attend bi-weekly virtual seminars
- ◆ Participate in a mentored research project and present at the UAlbany/FIU
- ◆ Maintain a 3.2+ GPA and security clearance eligibility
